<p>I enjoy reading and writing.</p> 	<p>Find out information about your favourite arctic animals. Where will you find the information that you need? How big is it? What foods does it like? What habitat does it live in?</p>	<p>Write a fact file on your favourite arctic animal. Include any interesting facts you have discovered and describe the habitat that it lives in. Perhaps you could include a picture too.</p>	<p>Create a poster about any book that you have read about arctic animals. The book could be fiction and non-fiction. Remember to include the title and characters.</p>
<p>I enjoy painting, drawing and creating.</p> 	<p>Make a drawing, painting or model of your favourite arctic animal. Pay attention to the colours you will use. What have you noticed about the colour of arctic animals?</p>	<p>Use different materials to create a collage picture of an arctic animal. Explore different textures and materials to use. What could you use to represent fur?</p>	<p>Make a model of the habitat that your favourite arctic animal lives in. What materials will you use to represent the environment? Perhaps you could include a model of the animal too.</p>
<p>I enjoy being active and doing hands-on activities.</p> 	<p>Make a gift for either your favourite arctic animal or for a snowman. What would they need? Consider what materials you can use to make it a very special gift.</p>	<p>Make up an arctic dance routine. Think about how the animals we have learnt about move. Do they slide on the ice? Swim in the water or fly in the air?</p>	<p>Create your very own snowman. What materials will you use? What will you use for the arms and legs? Does your Snowman have a name? Perhaps you could build a family of snowmen.</p>
