


Lesson	Activity
Phonics and hand-writing	<p>This week we are learning the sounds :</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: flex-start;"> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Down the body and dot for the head.</p> </div> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Down Nobby and over his net.</p> </div> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Down Maisie, mountain, mountain.</p> </div> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Around the dinosaurs bottom, up his tall neck & down to his toes.</p> </div> </div> <p>Watch the Jolly Phonics Song, tricky word song and Play phase 1 listening games to support your child's learning. Practice writing these letters.</p>
Wake & Shake	Joe Wicks daily workout.
Literacy	<p>This week our focus text is 'Emma Jane's Aeroplane.' Listen to the story on Tapestry and learn the vocabulary associated with this text (also on Tapestry and our class page on the school website). Talk about the places that Emma Jane flew to in the aeroplane. Learn about aeroplanes. Watch videos on YouTube of aeroplanes taking off and landing and talk about the parts of an aeroplane. Draw an aeroplane and label the parts, e.g. wings and cockpit, using your phonics. If you have flown in an aeroplane before, talk about your experience. There are many rhyming words in the story 'Emma Jane's Aeroplane'. Talk about what rhyming words are, identify some rhyming words in the story, and say or write a string of rhyming words, e.g. cat, hat, mat, bat.</p>
Choosing Time	Children can choose what to play with, this could be a creative activity, building a house from Lego or playing with dolls/people etc.
Snack	Use this time to talk to your child, encourage healthy eating .
Morning Air	Go for a walk, play in the garden, can you notice anything that has changed since yesterday?
Maths	<p>Show your child a variety of circles and triangles. Ask them what they notice? Are the sides curved or straight? Point out to your child how many sides each shape has. Which shape has the most sides? Turn the shapes around, are they still the same shape? Challenge your child to find a different shapes in their environment.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">   </div>
Quiet time	Read a book together or have ago at this meditation
Topic	<p>Draw a road track. Try and use different line shapes such as zig zags and wiggles. Once completed, use a small car or train and follow the lines.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around;">   </div> <p>Make a long tunnel to drive trains and cars through. You could use kitchen or toilet roll tubes or have fun making your own by rolling up piece of paper.</p>
