Phonics and hand-writing	<p>This week we are learning the sounds :</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: flex-start;"> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Lift off the top and scoop out the egg.</p> </div> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Down and under, up to the top and draw the puddle.</p> </div> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Down the robots back and curl over his arm.</p> </div> </div> <p>Watch the Jolly Phonics Song, trick word song and Play phase 1 listening games to support your child's learning. Practice writing these letters.</p>
Wake & Shake	<p>Joe Wicks daily workout.</p>
Literacy	<p>Talk about ways in which we are different and the same. Identify different types of homes (flats, bungalows, caravans). What town and country do you live in? Learn some facts about Reading. Talk about how different people come from different countries and learn about different ways of life in different countries. Draw a picture of your home and write key words about it using phonics, e.g. red door, two bedrooms.</p>
Choosing Time	<p>Children can choose what to play with, this could be a creative activity, building a house from Lego or playing with dolls/people etc.</p>
Snack	<p>Use this time to talk to your child, encourage healthy eating.</p>
Morning Air	<p>Go for a walk, play in the garden, can you notice anything that has changed since yesterday?</p>
Maths	<p>Compare size, mass, capacity:</p> <p>Place an object inside a mystery box. Get your child to hold the box, look it's size, feel how heavy it is. Now have a range of objects that might be in the box (big things, small things, heavy, light etc..) Get them to choose what they think is in the box and say why.</p> 
Quiet time	<p>Read a book together or have ago at this meditation</p>
Topic	<p>Collect leaves, twigs and other natural items in your garden or local park to create an autumn collage. See if you can make any woodland creatures.</p> <p>Make some homemade playdough. Ask you child to help with measuring the ingredients. Once cooled explore the playdough together. Knead, pinch, cut and squish to help develop fine motor skills.</p>
