Please ensure you are following all the procedures that have been set out to keep our children, staff and yourselves safe. Only one person from the household should be collecting from the playground. Please remember your face covering wearing it correctly over your mouth and nose, unless you are exempt. To keep safe, it may take a little longer, please continue to show respect towards everyone and as a reminder, mobile phones should not be used when on school site collecting from the playground, thank you.

Parking:

As we have returned to school this week, we need to be considerate of all our children, families and residents when dropping off and collecting. You must not be stopping your car in front of the school gate and dropping your child/children off, double parking or parking on double yellow lines. If needed, please park further away from the school and walk down. This week, one of our residents (a member of our community) had their car damaged. If you have any information about how this may have happened, please contact the school. My biggest fear is that one day, one of our children may be hurt - or worse - if we are not more considerate about being safe.



Uniform and PE:

Children are expected to return in full school uniform, if families are experiencing challenges with this please contact your class teacher via the year group email to let them know. Please remember to label all uniform.
